Why is e-resource access different?

- E-resources include, ebooks, ejournals, edatabases
- Subscription not ownership
 - License limitations
 - Concurrent users
 - Geographical restrictions

- Where to find OA content
 - [Core](#) – search OA research papers from around the world
 - [DOAJ](#) – Directory of Open Access Journals
 - [Open Access Button](#) – looks for an alternative source when you hit a paywall
 - [Unpaywall](#) – browser extension, search content from OA repositories and publishers


